31862	Resinated wood residuals	Non-wastes if they are used as fuels within the control of the generator; under the alternative approach, solid wastes when burned under the control of the generator for energy recovery
31862	Pulp and paper sludges	Non-wastes if they are used as fuels within the control of the generator; under the alternative approach, solid wastes when burned under the control of the generator for energy recovery
31863	Painted wood or pentachlorophenol, copper-based and borate-based wood materials	Solid waste
31863	Creosote treated lumber	Solid waste
31863	Manure (including materials, such as chicken litter)	Insufficient data. To be decided in final rule.
31863	Manure processed into biofuels	Insufficient data. To be decided in final rule.
31864	Whole used tires (even if collected from tire dealerships and automotive shops and overseen by a state tire collection oversight program)	Solid waste
31864	Tires that have been shredded/chipped with belts removed	Not solid waste
31864	Off-spec used oil burned as fuel	Solid waste
31865	Off-spec used oil burned in a used oil-fired space heater	Solid waste
31865	Coal refuse from "legacy" piles	Solid waste
31865	Currently generated coal refuse	Not solid waste
31866	Coal ash mined from landfills	Solid waste unless processed into legitimate non-waste fuel products
31866	Coal fly ash and mill rejects	Solid waste
31866	Coal refuse or coal mining rejects that have been placed in waste piles known as gob or culm	Solid waste
31866	Sewage sludge burned without energy recovery (i.e., burned for destruction)	Solid waste
31866	Sewage sludge burned in a waste heat recovery unit	Solid waste
31867	Sewage sludge generated from POTWs	Solid waste
